#### Bash I/O Redirection

• Redirects the output of one command to the input of another Ex: echo "hello" | nc chal.sigpwny.com 1337 > Redirects the output of one command to a file Ex: cat someFile.txt > newFile.txt >> Appends the output of one command to end of a file Ex: cat someFile.txt >> existingFile.txt Takes file contents as input to a command Ex: \$() Uses the output of any command as a parameter of another command Very useful for BOF attacks.

#### Tmux

**Terminal Multiplexor** 

Have different instances of terminal in one terminal window.

### **Tmux Basics**

tmux opens a tmux window, which is unlike a normal terminal window.

Once in tmux, the action command is cntrl + B

#### Some helpful things

Command (B + ?)	What it does
d	Detaches you from your tmux session
С	Creates a new tmux window
cc	Creates a horizontal split pane
%	Creates a vertical split pane
Arrow Keys	Navigates between panes
n (or 0-9)	Moves to next window (windows 0-9)

Multitask quickly (no mouse)

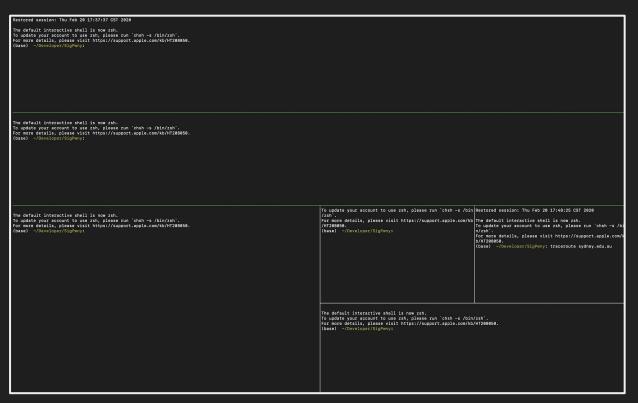
(If VM hosted somewhere) Keep things up for a long time
